1. Rationale

- 1.1. Effective communication between home and school are a key part of ensuring that students enjoy school and make good progress. Through proactive engagement with parents and carers we seek to further improve our students' experience and progress.

2. Aims

- 2.1. To ensure that parents/carers are kept up to date about their child's behaviour, progress, attendance and punctuality.
- 2.2. To enable a productive dialogue between home and school.
- 2.3. To keep parents/carers informed about the school and school events.

3. How will we keep parents/carers informed?

- 3.1. The My Child at School (MCAS) app is the downloadable software through which parents can access information about their child's timetable, homework, attendance, punctuality and behaviour. Importantly, this is also the platform the school uses to send all correspondence. For parents who do not wish to register for MCAS, communications are sent via email. MCAS also serves as a portal for accessing the virtual learning environment, ParentPay and the school website.
- 3.2. We use Cloudbox software for our virtual learning environment (VLE). This enables parents to view their child's timetable and any homework that has been set for them in any given period. It also offers a resourced course outline.
- 3.3. Our school website (<https://www.brian-clarke.org/>) has a range of key information which includes upcoming school events; school and trust policies and school term dates.
- 3.4. The half termly newsletter updates parents on key school issues in addition to keeping them abreast of the activities and events which have been taking place in school.
- 3.5. Parents receive a school report 3 times per year whilst their child is in Key Stage 3. This summative report contains information on their child's academic progress and/or their behaviour and effort in school.
- 3.6. Parents' evenings: During each academic year parents/carers are invited to attend a parents' consultation evening, providing opportunity for dialogue with either subject teachers or form tutor regarding the progress and attitudes to learning of their child.
- 3.7. Parents' Information Evening: Early in the academic year, parents/carers are invited to attend an information evening to hear the key information for the Year group.

3.7.1. The format of parents' evenings has been tailored to the needs of each year group. In Years 7 and 8, parents / carers have one extended appointment with their child's form tutor or a member of the senior leadership team. This member of staff will give holistic feedback on progress, attitudes to learning, learning behaviours.

3.8. Telephone/email: Should there be any issues arising during the academic year, we may contact parents/carers via email or telephone. We encourage our staff to be proactive and contact parents should they need to discuss any issue regarding a student at the earliest possible opportunity.

4. What should parents/carers do if they need to contact school?

4.1. Where parents/carers have a question or a concern we would always encourage that they get in touch with us as soon as possible by email (info@brian-clarke.org) or phone.

4.2. On occasion it may be that parents/carers need some advice on who is the best person to direct their enquiry to. For help with this please refer to our Key Contacts Guide below.

4.3. Email

4.3.1. To contact a member of staff by email, parents/carers should email info@brian-clarke.org, clearly identifying which member of staff it is for the attention of and what the email is regarding in the subject line e.g. FAO: Mr Smith RE: English Report for Sally Jones (Elm-JCO).

4.3.2. Emails will be passed to the appropriate member(s) of staff. They will respond as soon as possible and ideally the same day. However other commitments may mean this is not possible. Our expectation is that under normal circumstances all emails would receive a response within **two working days**.

4.3.3. Staff may respond via telephone to resolve issues more efficiently.

4.4. Telephone

4.4.1. Parents/carers may contact the school on **0161 785 5085**. A member of the reception team will direct the call to the most appropriate member of staff. If the staff member required is not available there will be the option of leaving a message.

4.4.2. As with email, staff will respond as soon as possible and ideally the same day. However other commitments may mean this is not possible. Our expectation is that under normal circumstances all telephone calls would be receive a response within **two working days**.

5.1 General Enquiries:

For most queries the most appropriate person to contact is your child's **Form Tutor**.

Form Tutors have a crucial role at Brian Clarke Academy and maintain an overview of each of their tutees across school. They will be able to give further information about the following:

- Attitudes to learning
- Behaviour and conduct
- Overall progress

They will also work to ensure that their tutees are happy and engaged in everything Brian Clarke has to offer.

For issues of a more serious or complicated nature form tutors will work with the **Director of Learning** for their year group.
